1.0 APOLOGIES

3.0 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

- a) WA/2025/01374 – Haybarn, Dye House Road, GU8 6QN
Erection of a single storey orangery

Following review of the plans it was resolved that the Parish Council had NO COMMENT regarding the application.

- b) WA/2025/01490 – Hedge Farm, Highfield Lane, GU8 6QJ
Erection of an extension to an outbuilding

Following review of the plans it was resolved that the Parish Council had NO COMMENT regarding the application.

- c) WA/2025/01481 & 01482 – Hill Farm, Highfield Lane, GU8 6QQ
Listed building consent for/erection of a single storey extension and internal and external alterations following removal of existing chimney.

Following review of the plans it was resolved that the Parish Council had NO COMMENT regarding the application. However, the Clerk was asked to raise the following points:

- That if WBC are minded to approve the application, it may be appropriate to include a requirement for a traffic management plan during the time that the building works are taking place.
- To highlight that questions were raised with regards to the symmetry of the building, although it was noted that there may be good reasons for the proposed layout, and that this would be a consideration for the Listed Buildings Officer.
- That the Parish Council welcome the proposed restoration of an important historical building within the village in order to protect and respect the heritage for future generations.
