1.0 APOLOGIES

3.0 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

- a) WA/2020/0754 – Hammer Pond Embankment
Amendment - construction of a new attenuating embankment structure and associated water control structures to reinstate Hammer Pond as a standing waterbody and gravity-fed flows to three adjoining watercourses

Following review of the plans it was resolved that the Parish Council had no comment to make on the amended application.

It was agreed that a letter be written to WBC and Natural England advising that in the interest of parishioners it was important that a maintenance plan be put in place as part of the conditions of the planning process. **Cllr Mendelssohn agreed to prepare a draft letter in advance of a meeting with Cllr Flavell the following day.**

Mr Powell raised a concern about a dangerous situation of a tree which had fallen into Fork pond resulting in walkers having to stoop down under a branch. **Cllr Mendelssohn agreed to speak to James Giles.**

Mr & Mrs Powell left the meeting at 6.55 pm.

b) WA/2020/1253 – Thursley Village Hall, Dye House Road, GU8 6QD
Erection of extension and alterations
